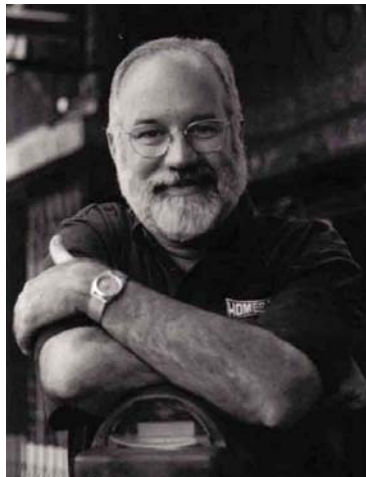
Save the Date for Sacramento Act
