The Sharing Table

Before or after enjoying a wonderful brunch in Fellowship Hall, come to the Sharing Table to shop for garden fresh vegetables and fruits, homemade goodies, and books. Proceeds of the Sharing Table go to Heifer International, which helps low income families by providing farm animals and training. The goal this summer is to help villages develop, such as the villages of Borynia and Komarnyky in the Ukraine. Fifty-five families will share 25 Simmental-breed heifers, 50 bee packages, 10 young sows, 1 boar and ornamental plant saplings. An additional 55 families will benefit from "passing on the gift." Heifer International will improve the villagers' knowledge of agricultural production and processing and of green tourism. The project hopes to establish an education and production center to provide training on small scale milk and meat processing for project participants and the larger community.
