The First Sunday Table at St. Mark's provides a connection to organizations in our community who help those in need. As the days grow colder and wetter, those needs increase. An unexpected tragedy also interrupts needed services as the recent fire at River City Food Bank. Thanks to our congregational response, John McCormack, Chair of the Ministry in Action Commission, reported "A large shipment of non-perishable food was delivered today to the River City Food Bank's temporary warehouse at Trinity Episcopal Cathedral... Please continue to support this effort by bringing additional non-perishable food (and new diapers) ... or placing a check in the offering plate. Ministry in Action will ensure that every donation gets to those persons who are hungry. The other organizations St. Mark's supports through the First Sunday Table also need our help: Loaves & Fishes, Wellspring Women's Center, Francis House, and the Central Downtown Food Basket. Checks payable to these organizations left at the table are mailed as a group to show St. Mark's support. Information about their holiday needs can be found at the table. Items for guests at Loaves & Fishes and families at Family Promise may be left at the table as well as groceries for St. Mark's own food closet and paperback books for county jail inmates.
