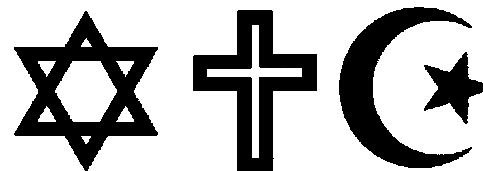


Growing Up Great
